



Field Trip Scholarships at the Yakima Valley Museum

Thanks to generous funding from the Ruth Luhman Foundation at St. Timothy's Episcopal Church, the Yakima Valley Museum is proud to offer funding to subsidize the cost of field trips for schools within ESD 105 to have the opportunity to experience engaging and interactive educational exhibits and programs, regardless of financial barriers. To serve as many students as possible with this funding, scholarships can fund up to \$140 for travel and up to \$250 for admissions and will be awarded to schools on a first-come, first served basis until funds are depleted.

A limited number of scholarships are available and must follow the below guidelines:

- Your school must be located within ESD 105.
- The field trip must be scheduled and confirmed with Yakima Valley Museum staff.
- One scholarship, per school, per semester.
- Schools must arrange their own transportation.
- Teachers are required to submit an application. Once the application is received, a representative from the Yakima Valley Museum will notify you of the status of the application and confirmation of your field trip date and time. You are not guaranteed the funds until you receive an official confirmation from the Yakima Valley Museum.

Please Note:

- Guided Tours of the Yakima Valley Museum are available from Tuesday through Friday, 10am until 4pm.
- Applications must be received at least two weeks prior to the planned visit. Applications will not be considered if they are submitted within two weeks of the Field trip date.
- We require that you obtain a bus transportation quote of invoice showing trip information and the approximate cost of the bus in advance and submit it together with the application. We will cover up to the max amount (\$140) for travel. For schools with invoices that are less than the max amount, we will cover the amount on the invoice.
- A completed W-9 form must be completed before the funds are disbursed.
- Applications will not be processed without a bus transportation quote or invoice.
